

**Resolution of the Crozet Community Advisory Council
Regarding Implementation of Traffic Measures on U.S. Route 250
May 16, 2013**

WHEREAS the development of the Clover Lawn property and Radford Lane has resulted in increased vehicular and pedestrian activity along an already busy section of U.S. Route 250;

WHEREAS traffic accidents in this location have resulted in two pedestrian fatalities in the last two years; and

WHEREAS the Crozet Community Advisory Council is concerned about the safety of the citizens of Crozet and all of western Albemarle County and desires that the Albemarle County Board of Supervisors and the Virginia Department of Transportation take action to address this pressing issue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Crozet Community Advisory Council requests that the Albemarle County Board of Supervisors and the Virginia Department of Transportation take immediate action to install new safety improvements in the vicinity of Clover Lawn and Radford Lane on U.S. Route 250.
