Resolution Regarding Crozet Elementary Expansion

August 21, 2019

WHEREAS, the Long-Range Planning Advisory Committee (LRPAC) has drafted a report making recommendations to the Albemarle County School Board (School Board) about FY21-FY25 Capital Improvement Plan funding;

WHEREAS, the data and projections presented by LRPAC show significant current and future overcrowding at Crozet Elementary and Brownsville Elementary;

WHEREAS, LRPAC recommends expanding Crozet Elementary as a way to alleviate the overcrowding at both schools;

WHEREAS, LRPAC ranks the Crozet Elementary expansion as its top capacity-related project;

WHEREAS, the Crozet Community Advisory Committee (CCAC) has heard serious concerns from the Crozet community about overcrowding in its area schools, including Brownsville Elementary and Crozet Elementary, and shares those concerns;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the CCAC supports LRPAC's recommendation to prioritize the Crozet Elementary addition and urges the School Board to give the project the highest possible priority as part of its FY21-25 Capital Improvement Plan funding request.
